2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6052, sub-§4, as amended by PL 2017, c. 284, Pt. QQ, §3, is further amended to read:
4 5	4. Research. Serve as the primary state agency engaging in research for the conservation of marine resources; and engage in all aspects of marine research, including:
6 7	A. Providing information on stock levels and environments of commercially and recreationally valuable marine and anadromous fish organisms;
8 9	B. Solving particular problems that relate to the State's commercial, marine recreational and anadromous fishing industry;
10 11	C. Providing technical and scientific information and support for all department activities; and
12 13 14 15	D. Establishing a marine research revolving fund for soliciting and receiving funds for conducting marine research. A marine research fund established under this paragraph may be used only for research purposes set forth under paragraphs A and B and may not be used for research specific to any one company; <u>and</u>
16	E. Establishing criteria for a permit to conduct research in the intertidal zone;
