3 SUMMARY

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This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, requires the Department of Health and Human Services to submit a waiver request no later than January 1, 2018 to the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to implement the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, section 3174-ZZ. The department is required to take all reasonable and necessary steps to seek approval of the waiver. Upon approval of the waiver, the department is directed to adopt rules no later than 180 days after receiving approval. The department is required to report its progress in seeking a waiver and implementing rules on a quarterly basis beginning October 1, 2017 until the process is complete. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
