Legislative Email



Your Legislature email address:

firstname.lastname@legislature.maine.gov

- Based on your name as it appeared on ballot
- Modifying to use nicknames is okay within reason, but only one you're commonly known by. (To use a nickname or other, fill out green Email Change Request Form and submit to LIT, SH Room 262)
- This is the email address that will be exposed to the general public via all avenues: web links, register, etc..

What we'll use your email for:

- Email is the <u>primary</u> method of communication for the Legislature
 - Daily Calendars
 - Public hearings and work sessions on your bills
 - Committee schedules
 - Rule making notices
 - HR, Benefits information
 - Emergency closures and postponements
 - General announcements
 - Communications with staff

How to get your email: Option #1

Outlook Web Access (Webmail) in a web browser

- *URL: webmail.mainelegislature.org
- Login required: (use the user name and password provided to you at the Pre-Legislative Conference in December)

Option #2 : Mobile Apps

 Outlook (Microsoft) (recommended)



- OWA Webmail
- (Good, light alternative, ad supported)



Why use Legislative email? I like my Gmail!!

<u>Past</u>: In years past, using a personal email account that was easily accessible from a mobile device and familiar app was a valuable option

<u>Now</u>: Now there are a number of good mobile device apps that allow you to directly access your Legislative email from your cell phone, tablet or other with a more familiar interface

Why?

Why is it important to use your Legislative Account?


- IT'S ARCHIVED! When email is sent to or from your Legislative email account, it passes through our email system here where it is **archived** before being sent on it's way either to your inbox or on to the outside
- Should you be the target of a FOAA request, the archives can be searched to provide a response to the requestor
- If you use a personal account to conduct business and that account shows up on a FOAA request, you can be asked to provide all correspondence from that account as well -- Goggle will be of no help

Legislative Email Organization



Email Servers, Security, Legislative Records Management, Retrieval.

- All Legislative email (inbound and outbound) is securely archived on our servers for storage and retrieval
- We strongly encourage that all legislative communications be handled through your legislative email account using one of the several avenues previously mentioned
- Note: You may also allow your aide access to your Legislative email. Contact LIT at 287-1625 to request this access

Personal Mobile Devices, Texting, Social Media - FOAA

 You are STRONGLY advised not to conduct official Legislative business on mobile devices via texting, Facebook Messenger and/or other Social Media

Reason: In case of a FOAA request, <u>you</u> will be responsible to extract and provide those communications.

 If you choose to use a personal email account to conduct official business, we recommend that you CC yourself through your legislative email account so that a record of communication is received for archiving
