Re: LD 10, An Act To Allow Resident Hunters To Harvest 2 Bears per Bear Hunting Season (Davis)

Summary

This bill allows bear hunters who are residents of the State to take 3 bears per bear hunting season; two by hunting and one by trapping. Nonresidents may take 2 bears per bear hunting season; one by hunting and one by trapping.

Testimony

Proponents: Senator Paul Davis (sponsor); Harvey Calden, Maine Sporting Camp Assoc.; Julie-Ann Smith, ME Farm Bureau Assoc.; Steve Wood, JS Wood

- Nonresidents should have same limits as residents; consistency
- In support, but also in support of LD 142

Opponents: Mary Throckmorton; John Glowa, Sr.; Robert Bryan, BHA; Don Kleiner, MPGA; Melissa Gates, Animal Rights Maine; Wendy Andresen; Katie Hansberry, Humane Society of the US

- Bear baiting is a significant factor to increased bear populations, increased hunting will not address the problem.
- Bag limits should be determined through WMDs, not statewide
- Nonresidents, who make up significant portion of bear hunters, are at a disadvantage
- Focus should be on non-lethal management techniques
- Reject LD 10 in favor of considering LD 142

• Support the goal, but would prefer the committee consider LD 142, which reflects work done last year
