Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Department of Health and Human Services will require an allocation of \$65,000 in fiscal year 2017-18 and \$130,000 begining in fiscal year 2018-19 to add to the newborn screening program the lysosomal storage disorders known as Krabbe, Pompe, Gaucher, Fabry and Niemann-Pick diseases. Current newborn screening fees would be increased from \$110 to \$120 per baby in order to cover these additional costs.
