## **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$609,772 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$1,830,865 in fiscal year 2024-25 for an increase in case management services due to eligibility requirement changes. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included for the FMAP match.
