COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 412, L.D. 593, Bill, “An Act To Require That Carbon Monoxide Detectors Be Installed inside Educational Facilities”

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

**Sec. 2. Reimbursement.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Commissioner of Education shall establish procedures to reimburse local school administrative units for 90% of the cost of purchasing and installing carbon monoxide detectors in educational facilities pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 25, section 2468, subsection 2-A.

**Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF  
Carbon Monoxide Detectors for Schools N153**

Initiative: Provides funds for the purpose of paying 90% of the total cost to local school administrative units to purchase and install carbon monoxide detectors in educational facilities.
