15 16	<b>1. Hours for sale of liquor.</b> Except as provided in paragraphs A to D, licensees may sell or deliver liquor from $65$ a.m. on any day until 1 a.m. of the following day.
17 18	A. Licensees may not sell liquor on Sunday between the hours of 6 a.m. and 9 a.m., except on March 17th.
19	B. Licensees may sell liquor on January 1st of any year from 12 midnight to 2 a.m.
20 21 22 23	(1) In areas in which liquor may be sold except on Sundays, if January 1st falls on a Monday, licensees may sell or deliver liquor between 9 p.m. Sunday, December 31st and 2 a.m. January 1st, notwithstanding any local option decisions to the contrary.
24 25	D. Wholesale licensees may sell or deliver liquor to licensed establishments from 4 a.m. on any day until 1 a.m. the following day.'

27 28 29 30	This amendment replaces the bill, which proposes to amend current law to allow licensees to sell or deliver liquor as early as 5 a.m. any day of the week. This amendment allows for the 5 a.m. sale and delivery of liquor Monday through Saturday but maintains current law prohibiting sale until 9 a.m. on all Sundays, except for Sundays falling on March 17th
