1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §12501-A, sub-§12, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 427, §2, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8	12. Return service. "Return service" means service in public elementary or secondary school or private school in this State approved for tuition purposes for a full school year as a certified teacher or a speech pathologist, service as a Jobs for Maine's Graduates specialist with similar teacher certification or service for a 12-month period in a child care facility by an individual who has attained child care provider qualifications.

9 SUMMARY

This bill changes the Educators for Maine Program by including certain participants in the Jobs for Maine's Graduates program as eligible for loan forgiveness.
