23 24 25	2. Other functions. A school physician health advisor may perform other medical and health-related duties assigned by the school board, which may include all or some of the following:
26 27	A. Examine and diagnose students referred by teachers and other school employees to protect against the outbreak of contagious diseases in the schools;

29	C. Advise and serve as medical consultant to the school nurse; or

The amendment removes from the bill a provision on local health officer duties.
