Resolved: That the Legislative Council shall provide 3 necessary staffing services to the task force except that Legislative Council staff support 4 is not authorized when the Legislature is in regular or special session. The office of the 5 Secretary of the Senate and office of the Clerk of the House must provide staff assistance 6 to the task force upon request by the task force; and be it further

- 7 **Sec. 7. Preliminary report. Resolved:** That, no later than December 4, 2013, 8 the task force shall submit for presentation to the Second Regular Session of the 126th 9 Legislature a preliminary report that includes the recommendations of the task force 10 regarding the study, including recommendations that can be implemented immediately 11 and recommendations for a pilot program; and be it further
- 12 **Sec. 8. Final report. Resolved:** That, no later than November 5, 2014, the task 13 force shall submit a report that includes its findings and recommendations, including 14 suggested legislation, for presentation to the First Regular Session of the 127th 15 Legislature.'
  - SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House each appoint one public member of the task force instead of having the Governor appoint public members. It requires the task force to study strategies for remote citizen participation and to make pilot program recommendations. It provides that the office of the Secretary of the Senate and office of the Clerk of the House assist the task force upon request. It also provides that the task force submit a preliminary report by December 4, 2013 and in addition a final report on November 5, 2014.
