## 3 **SUMMARY** 4 This amendment establishes a definition of "electronic funds transfer" as it applies to 5 payment of prizes and provides that a check or electronic funds transfer may be provided 6 to a minor's family or guardian for payment of a prize issued by the Maine State Lottery 7 or under the Tri-state Lotto Compact. The amendment also clarifies the bill with regard 8 to authorizing administration of instant ticket games under the Tri-state Lotto Compact by 9 inserting appropriate references.
