1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2357, sub-§2, ¶ E, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 652, §3, is amended to read:
4 5 6	E. On the tri-axle unit of a 4-axle single-unit vehicle registered as a farm truck under section 505 and hauling potatoes, 64,000 pounds. This paragraph is repealed October 1, 2013.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	Current law allows a 4-axle single-unit vehicle registered as a farm truck and hauling potatoes a tolerance weight of 64,000 pounds until October 1, 2013. This bill removes the date restriction.
