6	summons, is issued for a violation of rules adopted by the department that adopt by
7	reference federal regulations found in 49 Code of Federal Regulations that is not an
8	out-of-service order as defined in section 558 subsection 1-A

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13 14 This bill prohibits a state police officer or motor carrier inspector from disseminating information from a report prepared in connection with a roadside inspection of a motor carrier if a warning, rather than a summons, is issued for a violation of United States Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration regulations that is not an out-of-service order.
