1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §3360-O, as enacted by PL 2001, c. 439, Pt. Z, §1, is amended
by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The board may adopt routine technical rules under chapter 375, subchapter 2-A to establish prerequisites applicable to persons who wish to participate in sexual assault forensic examiner training and authorize the issuance of certificates to those who complete the training. The process of sexual assault forensic examiner training and issuance of certificates under this section does not constitute a license or licensing action under chapter 375, subchapter 5.

SUMMARY

11 This bill allows the Sexual Assault Forensic Examiner Advisory Board the authority 12 to issue certificates to persons who complete sexual assault forensic examiner training 13 and provides that certification by the board does not constitute licensing under the Maine 14 Administrative Procedure Act.
