An Act To Extend the Date for a Business in a Tier 2 Location To Qualify for Pine Tree Development Zone Benefits

4	5. Termination. A qualified Pine Tree Development Zone business located in a tier
5	1 location or a tier 2 location may not be certified under this subchapter after December
6	31, 2018, and a qualified Pine Tree Development Zone business located in a tier 2
7	location may not be certified under this subchapter after December 31, 2013. All Pine
8	Tree Development Zone benefits provided under this subchapter are terminated or
9	December 31, 2028.
10	Sec. 2. Retroactivity. That section of this Act that amends the Maine Revised
11	Statutes, Title 30-A, section 5250-J, subsection 5 applies retroactively to December 31
12	2013.
13	SUMMARY
14	This bill extends until December 31, 2018 the ability of a business located in a tier 2
15	Pine Tree Development Zone to be certified to receive Pine Tree Development Zone
16	benefits. Currently, the expiration for such certification in tier 2 is December 31, 2013
17	and in tier 1 is December 31, 2018.
