LD 1007, An Act Relating to Precious Metal Coins

**Summary:** This bill exempts from the sales tax gold and silver coins minted by the United States Department of the Treasury, United States Mint.

- The sponsor presented the bill and provided written testimony.
- Those testifying in support of the bill include a cosponsor, who read written testimony from an interested citizen into the record, and a representative of the Defense of Liberty PAC.
- *Major points:* includes Gold Eagles, Silver Eagles, pre-1965 quarters and dimes, pre-1970 half dollars and other coins that are all legal tender; over 20 states do not charge sales tax; current taxation may deter coin shows from coming to Maine.
