LD 1164, An Act To Allow Cooperative Housing Owners Who Are Blind To Qualify for the Property Tax Exemption

Summary: Current law exempts from property tax the first \$4,000 of residential real estate owned and occupied by a person who is legally blind. This bill allows a person who is legally blind and who lives in cooperative housing to qualify for that same property tax exemption.
