## LD 279, An Act To Sustain Maine's Aviation Industry by Extending the Exemption from Sales and Use Tax for Aircraft and Parts

**Summary:** This bill permanently exempts aircraft and aircraft parts from Maine's sales and use tax. The exemption is currently scheduled to expire on June 30, 2015.
