LD 734, An Act Relating to the Sales Tax Exemption on Depreciable Equipment Used in Commercial Wood Harvesting

Summary: This bill provides that the sales tax exemption or refund for depreciable equipment used in commercial wood harvesting applies only when the harvesting is performed by residents of the United States or by business entities with headquarters in the United States.

Public Hearing:

Proponents

- The sponsor presented the bill, provided information regarding bonded workers and indicated he would support expanding the bill to include agriculture and commercial fishing.
- A representative of the Professional Logging Contractors of Maine testified in support of the bill.
