In Senate Chamber Monday June 6, 2005

Senate called to order by President Beth Edmonds of Cumberland County.

Prayer by Chaplain (LTC) Valmore G. Vigue, JFHQ-ME, State Chaplain Maine National Guard.

CHAPLAIN VIGUE: Good morning. In honor of Armed Forced Day, I'd like to share an inspirational thought about heroes before I pray. From my youth, we considered heroes to be people almost bigger than life. I had the same range of heroes that you did, from the Lone Ranger to Batman. They always showed up in the nick of time and saved the day. They were superheroes with strength beyond their enemies and pose in the face of disaster. Real life has altered my view of heroes. Today, in the aftermath of recent deployments, my heroes are more down to earth and look a lot like you and me. I've learned that real heroes are ordinary people placed in extraordinary circumstances. Without naming names, I'd like to describe some of these heroes.

Heroes number one and two are actually a husband and wife team from central Maine. I met this dynamic couple on a wet and cold night as I joined a Death Notification Officer to make a notification of a death in Iraq. The experience was one I will never forget and one I hope is never duplicated. The news of their son's death brought pain and sorrow beyond the imagination of any one except those who have also lost a child. In the days that followed, these dear people showed strength and courage that brought them to the top of my hero list. They remained faithful to their country, their President, and their National Guard community. They continued to honor others who are serving. They continued to show character and grace despite their loss. They hurt deeply but held their heads high to honor their son. It brought tears to my eyes just to be in their presence. It was humbling to be around them. They were so empowered with all that was right and good. So engrained with the values of our great nation, they exemplified in every way the best of what it is to be an American citizen. They are my heroes.

Hero number three is a dear friend who was wounded in the suicide attack in the cafeteria near Mosul more than a year ago now. I maintained e-mail contact with this friend throughout his days in Iraq. For the most part, things were quiet and safe, but on that fateful day, sitting next to a new acquaintance in the mess hall, a loud explosion, a flash of light, and everything changed. He awoke to smoke and dust, mass confusion, people screaming, and others crying out in pain, which he now could not hear. Despite his hearing loss, he quickly began moving to his fallen comrades. The friend who had been at his side had perished. He hastened through the charred remains of the tent, giving his blessing to those deceased and those injured. He was driven by a sense of urgency and duty, of loyalty and selfless service. No one was telling him what to do, rather his service came naturally to this man who had loved soldiers, his country, and his fellow

mankind all his life. I am humbled by and in awe of this dear man. When I saw him upon his return, tears welled up within me because I was in the presence of another one of my heroes. He exemplifies again all the best of what it means to be an American.

I have learned that heroes are ordinary people who are placed in extraordinary circumstances. This fact reminds me that any one of us can be a hero. Only the circumstances separate us from that honored status. We all realize that at a moment's notice the circumstances could thrust us into the hero's role. It is not something we will think about. It is not something we seek to be. It is rather the result of who we are and how we will respond in extraordinary circumstances.

The military community I have to know over the past 15 years is a community of heroes. I have gained the utmost respect for the men and women who proudly wear the uniform for the Maine National Guard. In a spirit of appreciation for those who have been pressed into service, and a spirit of anticipation for the moment our turn comes, may we all continue to exhibit our moral and spiritual values through selfless service and mutual respect. May God bless you as you commit yourselves to the support of this nation and the freedom of downtrodden peoples around the world, even as you serve here in the Maine Senate. Shall we pray.

Our Father God, You have guarded and preserved us as a nation for almost 230 years. We are still a young nation but nevertheless we understand that what we have is very special and very fragile. Our strength is our people. Our minds are our greatest weapons. Our freedom is our great motivation. We take none of these lightly. We call upon You, as did our forefathers, to protect us, to inspire us, to heal us, and to purify us. We have learned that freedom without self-restraint leads to chaos. Bless this assembly of men and women who serve to guard our freedom through the writing and application of law to prevent chaos and bring order and decency to our communities within this great State of Maine. Father, thank You for our military, which extends well beyond our borders, fighting terrorism at its roots, away from our peaceful shores. Thank You for the work our men and women in uniform perform. Though out of sight, they are not out of mind. We honor them today. In our Savior's name, Amen.

Senator **TURNER**: Thank you, Madame President. This bill seeks to clarify where an off-track betting facility may physically be located in reference to a racino. Under the current bill that is before you, without this amendment, it would be possible for an off-track betting facility with a smoking venue to be physically housed or encased inside a racino. The amendment simply clarifies that the racino must be physically separated from the off-track betting facility. It's an attempt to try to ensure that smoking in a racino is kept physically separate from an off-track betting facility. Thank you.

While I understand what the good Senator from Cumberland, Senator Turner, is attempting with the amendment, I think a careful reading of Committee Amendment "A" (H-528) does address some of this particular issue and that this amendment is placing a restriction on the racino and OTB that is not needed and could work against both situations. It is for that reason that I strongly urge indefinite postponement.

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Senator from Cumberland, Senator Turner.

Senator **TURNER**: Thank you, Madame President, ladies and gentlemen of the Senate. In an ever so brief response, I am glad I did not begin by saying this was a friendly amendment since the good Senator from Sagadahoc, Senator Mayo, does not construe it to be thus. It does seem to me that clarification is needed. I read the bill as it is currently before us and do believe that it is possible to house an off-track betting facility physically inside or allow it to be encased by a racino. I don't think that is the intent of what we want to have. This simply makes it crystal clear that it would not be allowed. A racino could be adjacent to an off-track betting facility but would not encase it. Thank you.

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen.

Senator **ROSEN**: Thank you, Madame President and members of the Senate. The bill that is before us is a bill that was introduced by the good Representative Deb Hutton and it was to address the negative impact of the private non-medical institution service provider tax that was adopted last session. The discovery is that the population that makes up many of these private non-medical institutions in our communities many times have a very small Medicaid clientele and consists of a fair number of people that are self-pay or private pay.

The Health and Human Services Committee heard from several of these people that are directly impacted out of their own pockets and severely impacted by the 5% PNMI tax. There were two in particular really that came to mind. There was a gentleman around 75 years old. He was responsible for his 100-year-old uncle. There was also a woman who was responsible for taking care of her husband. In both cases they came before the committee and described their view of the state's responsibility, their view of being responsible citizens, and they talked about their own personal stories. Having worked hard, been selfsufficient, raised a family, saved enough money to help their children make it through school, paid the mortgage off on the house, and saved a little bit of money. They now find themselves with a member of their family in a facility, paying out of their own savings for the services that they are receiving, and now being assessed a 5% tax. The lady from southern Maine that came before us was very eloquent. She indicated that the impact that this out-of-pocket for her is \$5,000 a year. It was interesting because her attitude reflected that of many other folks that we saw before the committee. That really was an attitude of being perplexed. I think they weren't necessarily angry, but they felt as though they had lived their lives according to the rules of the game, they had fended for themselves, they had carried the load of citizenship, they had set aside a small savings, they were paying their own way, and they were quite perplexed now to see that they were being assessed several thousands of dollars for a tax to fund this system. They were disappointed. They were concerned. They were worried that they were going to be drawing down their savings at a much more rapid rate and ultimately finding themselves eligible for Medicaid sooner than they had expected. I think this is what probably prompted the good Representative to put forward this bill and I think it is particularly important that we all understand that this impact is being felt by many families throughout the state as a result of this tax.

Having said that, the bill, unfortunately, is not practical for the people that operate these private non-medical institutions to have to absorb that tax themselves. They don't have the budgets to eat the tax. They are really forced to pass it along to the self-pay and the private pay individuals and really there is no way for them to absorb this, to remain in business, and to continue to operate their facilities. I recommend that we follow the motion that was made earlier by the Senate chair from Sagadahoc, Senator Mayo, and move the majority report.

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Senator from Sagadahoc, Senator Mayo.

Senator **MAYO**: Thank you, Madame President, ladies and gentlemen of the Senate. I would like to take this opportunity to

thank the good Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen, for his testimony on this particular bill. I understand the problems associated with it. There are a couple of other things to throw into this. One, the situation changes Bangor and north in that those nursing facilities have a preponderance of MaineCare residents, some of them approaching 95% and 98%. It really was not affecting them. As one of the good Senators would say, it affects only the gold coast and that may be the case. The point that the good Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen, about the nursing facilities not being able to absorb this 5% tax is entirely correct. It is estimated that if this bill did pass that we could lose a number of nursing facilities in this state because their margin is currently so small that if we put this tax upon them they are going to go under. I don't think that is what anybody in this body would like to do. Once again, I thank the good Senator and I hope that this body will accept the majority report.

THE PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes the Senator from Cumberland, Senator Brennan.

Senator BRENNAN: Thank you, Madame President, men and women of the Senate. I also appreciated the comments from the good Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen. Unfortunately, it is only part of the story. In fact, it's a very small part of the story. I'm sure that there are people who may have come forward and said that because of this particular tax they have had to contribute more to either the care of family members or spouses or whatever. The simple fact of the matter is when this issue was before the Health and Human Services Committee last year the decision was to whether or not to pass this tax or to cut those very same facilities \$8 million to \$10 million. This would have resulted in not a 5% tax to those people that the good Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen, just spoke about but it would be an 8% to 10% increase that would be levied on them as a result of a reduction in revenue from the state. The choice was whether or not we should pass this particular item in order to protect and shield in the situation that the good Senator from Hancock, Senator Rosen, just spoke of or whether or not we were to cut \$8 million to \$10 million which would have resulted in larger increases for those very same people. It is very unfair for this bill to be before us today and to now say that the providers cannot pass that tax along to those people when in fact this very action by the legislature provided economic relief for them in a larger context. Thank you.
