1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5**, as amended by PL 2017, c. 284, Pt. EEEEE, §14,  
3 is further amended to read:

4 **5. License fee.** Except as provided in ~~subsection~~ subsections 5-A and 5-B, the fee for  
5 a commercial shellfish license is \$58.25.

6 **Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5-A**, as amended by PL 2017, c. 284, Pt. EEEEE,  
7 §15, is further amended to read:

8 **5-A. Exception; age.** The fee for a commercial shellfish license for applicants 70  
9 years of age or older and applicants under 18 years of age is \$67, which must be deposited  
10 in the Shellfish Fund established under section 6651.

11 **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5-B** is enacted to read:

12 **5-B. Exception; veterans.** The department shall offer a 50% discount on the  
13 applicable license fee required under subsection 5 or 5-A to an applicant who is a veteran  
14 of the United States Armed Forces and who was honorably discharged.

15 **Sec. 4. Effective date.** This Act takes effect January 1, 2027.

16 **SUMMARY**

17 This bill directs the Department of Marine Resources to offer a 50% discount on the  
18 license fee to obtain a commercial shellfish license for an applicant who is a veteran of the  
19 United States Armed Forces and who was honorably discharged.
