The Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund, a nonlapsing, interest-bearing account within the Department of the Secretary of State, referred to in this section as "the fund," is established for the purpose of receiving funds from the State to support the costs associated with the production and delivery of election materials as required under this Title, including, but not limited to, ballots, absentee ballot envelopes, voter registration applications, forms, instructions and other election supplies. The use of funds from the fund is in addition to any funds received by the Department of the Secretary of State from the State for this purpose.
25	2. Funding. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before
26 27 28	September 30, 2024, and every September 30th thereafter, the State Controller shall transfer \$172,000 from the Medical Use of Cannabis Fund, established in Title 22, section 2430, to the Department of Secretary of State, Bureau of Administrative Services and

The use of funds from the fund is in addition to any other funds received by the department from the State for that purpose.
25 26 27 28 29 30	It also provides for an ongoing transfer to the Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund from the Medical Use of Cannabis Fund. In 2024 the transfer is \$172,000, and the amount must be adjusted for the cost of living every 2 years. Additionally, it provides for any remaining balances in the Department of Secretary of State, Bureau of Administrative Services and Corporations program, General Fund account at the end of each fiscal year to be transferred to the Production and Delivery of Election Materials Fund.
