LD 16 An Act to Make Technical Changes to Maine's Marine Resources Laws

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 207 does the following.

- 1. It amends the definition of "scallop" to include bay scallops.
- 2. It amends a definition of "shellfish" to include scallops.
- 3. It amends the definition of "whole scallop" to exclude the adductor muscle on the shell.
- 4. It clarifies that a license-holding member of the Passamaquoddy Tribe, Penobscot Nation, Aroostook Band of Micmacs or Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians is not required to complete the lobster fishery apprentice program if the license applicant has completed an apprentice program that satisfies the tribe, nation or band.
- 5. It replaces a license exemption for personal use to the commercial halibut fishing license, adds a violation for fishing for halibut without a commercial halibut fishing license and requires the Commissioner of Marine Resources to adopt rules for commercial halibut fishing licenses.
- 6. It allows the holder of an enhanced retail certificate to purchase shellfish from the holder of an aquaculture license.
- 7. It corrects cross-references in the administrative suspension process for licenses and certificates issued under marine resources laws.
- 8. It adds one member who is listed on the saltwater recreational fishing registry and who does not hold any state marine harvesting license to the Marine Resources Advisory Council.
- 9. It eliminates the secretary position within the Shellfish Advisory Council.
- 10. Beginning October 1, 2023, it removes the requirement of a limited-purpose aquaculture lessee to submit to the department a report on the lessee's seeding and harvesting for the prior year and a seeding and harvesting plan for the upcoming year. It also allows the commissioner to distribute a copy of the lessee's report on the results of the lessee's scientific research to the municipality or municipalities in which or adjacent to which the lease is located after the municipality submits a written request. The amendment also provides that, beginning October 1, 2023, a limited-purpose aquaculture lessee is no longer required to submit a report on commercial research and development.
- 11. It provides for a license or certificate suspension hearing to be held if the person requesting the hearing does not hold a license or certificate.
- 12. It amends the effective dates for changes to activities and exceptions allowed for a limited-purpose aquaculture license.

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LD 581 An Act to Assist Municipal Shellfish Conservation Programs

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 98 waives the application fee for limited-purpose aquaculture licenses issued to municipal shellfish management committees. It also waives the application fee for those licenses issued to municipal officers for municipal projects and provides that those fees are waived only if the organisms cultured are not used for commercial purposes. It also provides that the applicants who are exempt from those fees are also exempt from certain requirements to complete an educational course.

LD 817 An Act to Allow the Crew Member of a Holder of an Elver Fishing License to Empty an Elver Fyke Net

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 81 permits an unlicensed crew member of a holder of an elver fishing license to empty an elver fyke net.

Public Law 2023, chapter 81 was enacted as an emergency measure effective May 15, 2023.

LD 920 An Act Regarding Temporary Transfers of Elver Fishing Quotas for Medical Reasons

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 180 allows for an elver fishing license holder to request a temporary medical transfer of that license holder's quota at any point during the year and that the license holder receiving the transferred quota receives the amount of the transferor's quota that remains at the time the request is made. It also provides that the Commissioner of Marine Resources may adopt rules that allow for a transferor to choose whether the transferor retains the income and tax burden from the transferor's transferred quota or whether it is transferred to the license holder receiving the quota.

LD 1444 An Act to Amend the Laws Governing Eligibility Restrictions for Commercial Menhaden Fishing Licenses

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 169 provides that an individual who is otherwise eligible for a commercial menhaden fishing license in 2023 is not eligible for a 2nd commercial menhaden fishing license in 2023 if the individual previously held a 2nd license in 2022. It also allows the Commissioner of Marine Resources to establish by rule a limited entry system under which an

individual who did not hold a commercial menhaden fishing license in the previous calendar year may become eligible to obtain a license.

Public Law 2023, chapter 169 was enacted as an emergency measure effective June 15, 2023.

LD 1552 An Act to Create the Lobster Innovation Fund

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 466 establishes the Lobster Innovation Fund to provide stipends to holders of Class I, Class II or Class III lobster fishing licenses to participate in the testing of new lobster fishing technologies. It provides a one-time appropriation of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 and a base allocation for outside funding.

LD 1951 An Act Regarding Marine Finfish Aquaculture

ENACTED LAW SUMMARY

Public Law 2023, chapter 268 provides that a lease may not be issued for aquaculture of salmonid species if the proposed stocking density of pens in the lease area exceeds 30 kilograms per cubic meter.
