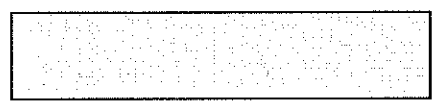

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order provides current year funding for one Government Intern position from May 28, 2024 to August 17, 2024, previously established by financial order in fiscal year 2024. The intern will assist with planning for the inspection of dams using drones and underwater cameras by helping to develop the written policy. The intern will also assist the engineer with measurements, photographs, sketches, and geo-locating dams across the state. The funding will be provided by the National Dam Safety grant from the US Department of Homeland Security. The Maine Dam Safety program facilitates emergency action planning with owners of all high and significant hazard dams in the State of Maine. All Other funds are no longer needed as the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management will meet its operational needs within existing resources. Failure to approve this order will result in the inability to continue to fund this intern position.

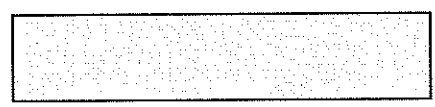

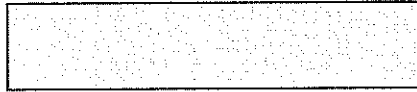

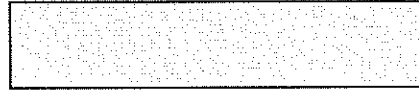

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order allots a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward to cover the cost of multimedia services to enhance marketing, communications and public relations and education efforts. The Commission's core function is to ensure that Maine citizens have access to safe and reliable utility services at rates that are just and reasonable for customers and public utilities. To help educate the public, funds will be used for: a safety campaign for the Dig Safe Program, social media graphic design for general education and outreach, a market survey, and a public-education campaign to inform electric utility customers about ways to help pay their electric bills.

Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the program resulting in the inability of the Commission to effectively educate the public, thus potentially causing adverse consequences in terms of cost, safety, and reliability for Maine consumers.
