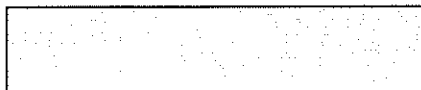

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward in the Department of Education (DOE) Departmental Services account and transfers funding from the Statewide - Positions Supporting SFRF Projects, Other Special Revenue Funds account to the DOE MJRP Administration account to continue 2 limited-period positions from November 23, 2025 through June 30, 2026. These positions are split funded between the MJRP Administration account, Other Special Revenue Funds and the Departmental Services account, Other Special Revenue Funds. These positions were established by Financial Order CV0803 F5 and continued by Financial Order 004393 F6 to provide subrecipient monitoring support to grant funding received through the American Rescue Plan Act. Public Law 2023, chapter 643, Part D allocates funding to support positions necessary to complete projects initially funded with funds received through the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and authorizes the extension of limited-period positions beyond 2 years. Failure to allot these funds will limit the department's ability to effectively monitor federal emergency relief funding.

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order provides allotment to purchase a Gas Chromatograph/Mass Spectrometer (GC/MS) instrument for the Maine Health and Environmental Testing Laboratory (HETL). A replacement GC/MS instrument is needed for the HETL Forensic Chemistry Section Seized Drug Unit to perform seized drug testing related to criminal investigations for every local, county and state police departments, as well as correctional facilities, attorneys, and other state agencies. The GC/MS instrument is the primary method of controlled substance identification available for HETL. Funding for the GC/MS instrument will replace current equipment, which is no longer reliable or cost effective. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose originally intended due to a reduction in contractual expenditures.

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order allots a portion of the \$1.7 million in funds associated with the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry (DACF) and the Maine Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (Maine CDC) to address per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) contamination. Specifically, Maine CDC will assist with the following tasks: establishing public health oversight of PFAS blood serum testing and developing public health education resources; conducting a farmer and farm worker soil exposure study; evaluating medical interventions to accelerate the removal of PFAS from exposed humans; analyzing laboratory data and methodologies; creating communication materials; and undertaking investigations of PFAS-contaminated sites to guide future work. Failure to allot these funds would result in the terms of the MOU going unmet.

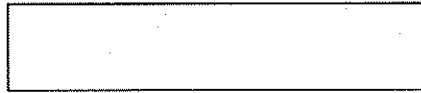

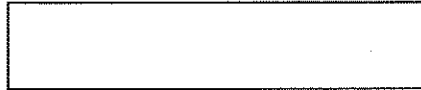

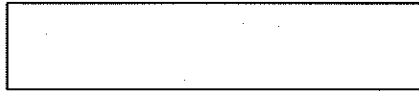
