

Statement of Fact


This financial order increases allotment in the All Other line category to reflect federal Americorps funding received under the Corporation for National and Community Service, ALN 94.006. These funds support AmeriCorps programs in Maine that place trained service members with local organizations to help address specific community needs. In the coming year, AmeriCorps service members will help low- and moderate-income Mainers with services such as legal paperwork assistance, understanding court processes, or connecting to legal aid. They will also serve in schools, health centers, and community organizations to build a healthier Maine by engaging youth in substance use prevention programs, developing food security initiatives, providing education around vaccinations, and creating community integration opportunities for individuals with disabilities. The funding will also pay for professional consulting services to develop a required three-year written state service strategy that explains how Maine will use national service programs to address critical needs in Maine over the next three years which must include opportunities for public input.
