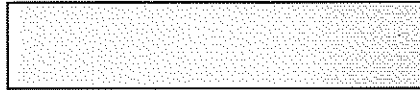

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller increase allotment in account 010-18F-0002-07, Maine Revenue Services, in the All Other line category and decrease the allotment in account 010-18F-0886-01, Reimbursement - Homestead Property Tax Exemption, in the All Other line category for the purpose of funding the operational expenditures of Maine Revenue Services; and,

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2026", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

Maine Revenue Services anticipates a shortfall in the projected business activities for the second half of the fiscal year. Additionally, Maine Revenue Services will make Direct File available to Maine taxpayers this next filing season to file their federal income taxes and will work with the IRS to fully integrate Direct File and the Maine Tax Portal for future filing seasons, with a goal of completion in 2026. The funds in the Reimbursement - Homestead Property Tax Exemption account are no longer needed since all required payments have been processed for this fiscal year.

that the State Controller increase allotment in account 029-18K-0713-01, Financial and Personnel Services Fund, by \$37,365 in the Personal Services line category and by \$3,032 in the All Other line category for the purpose of funding this position and related All Other costs; and,

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2026", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order establishes one limited-period Senior Staff Accountant position beginning March 2, 2026, and ending March 1, 2028. This position will be funded through the Maine's Rural Health Transformation Plan, a five-year grant awarded to the State of Maine's Department of Health and Human Services. This position will be responsible for providing financial and accounting support for the increased workload that the Department of Health and Human Services Financial Service Center will be responsible for and will oversee the implementation of the grant to ensure compliance with standard financial operating practices. Funding is provided through the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, ALN 93.798. Failure to allot will result in the Department of Health and Human Services Financial Service Center's inability to provide the additional resources needed to manage this grant.

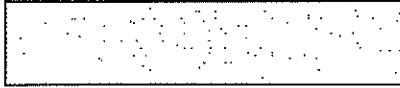

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the unencumbered balance forward to establish one limited-period Marine Scientist I position. The position will use scientific skills while being assigned to maintain, analyze and develop representative community classifications based on video and still imagery. The position will work within a larger group to sort, identify and develop community classifications of benthic infauna and epifauna samples. The position will begin on February 12, 2026 and will end February 11, 2028. Failure to approve this financial order will result in the department's inability to complete the scope of work necessary to meet grant requirements.
