



Statement of Fact


This financial order will allot a portion of the \$300,000 in funds from the Jobs for the Future - Fair Chance to Advance State Action Networks, a Pass-Through/subaward agreement. These network programs will focus on aligning the state's public systems for corrections, postsecondary education and workforce development to build broader pathways from incarceration to quality jobs. The Maine Department of Corrections was awarded grant dollars through Jobs for the Future. Funding will be used for phase 1 of the project (2/1/26 to 1/31/28) and would cover three (3) out of state conferences held March 2026 and tentatively November 2026 and November 2027; two (2) in-state half-day summits in January 2027 and October 2027. Out-of-state and in-state convenings would include any travel expenses and incidentals. In-state summits would include space rental, materials/supplies, mileage, and incidentals. In addition to these expenses, the grant requires non-state employee committee members to be reimbursed for their time at meetings and any mileage associated with these meetings. Failure to allot these funds will result in inability to pay for these necessary state conferences.
