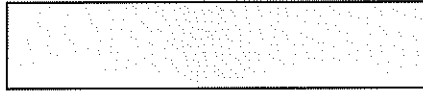

**Statement of Fact**

The intern will support the Talent Management and Compliance divisions by conducting informal staff interviews, reviewing internal training programs, strengthening communication and outcome-focused problem solving skills. Through this experience, the intern will gain a holistic understanding of HR operations in the public sector. The position will be funded by a transfer from the All Other line category. Funds are no longer needed in the All Other line category for the purpose for which they were originally intended because fewer professional services contracts will be needed than originally budgeted. Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the department's ability to participate in the intern program.

These interns will provide support to Energy, Engineering, and Environmental Managers assisting with energy audits across Army National Guard facilities statewide; environmental surveys of wetlands, vernal pools, acoustic bat studies, endangered species and other wildlife; and biological assessments for permitting new ranges at the Lola-Dana Training Site in Woodville, Maine. The interns will be performing data analysis, map creation and producing written reports using Microsoft Office and engineering software. The positions are funded 100% from Federal Expenditures Fund under the Master Cooperative Agreement between the State of Maine and the National Guard Bureau. All Other funds are no longer needed as actual expenses are lower than budgeted.

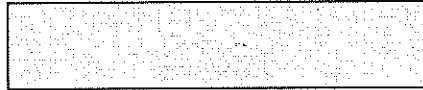

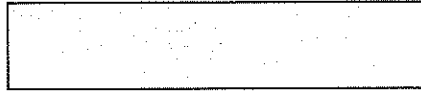
