It also allows dedicated specialty plate funds to be used for the intended purpose. Failure to allot these funds will result in the inability to issue specialty plates.

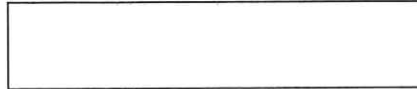
