These funds will be used for a study of the existing building where the Office of Chief Medical Examiner is located, including facility evaluation, programming and needs study, preliminary cost estimates and options. This review is necessary as the Office strives: to meet current and future needs of operations by accommodating increasing caseloads; to reach national accreditation requirements; and to ensure OSHA and local building certification standards. The existing facility has a number of shortfalls that must be addressed to ensure the health and safety of staff and surrounding community as well as to ensure successful ongoing forensic operations for the people of the State of Maine. Failure to allot these funds will stall the efforts of the facility evaluation and upgrades and may jeopardize national accreditation.
