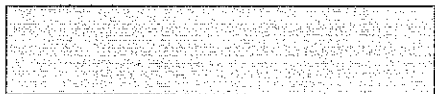

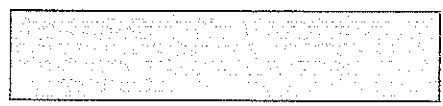

The HPLC system is an essential piece of equipment needed to remain in compliance with the NSSP. This expenditure will replace the need to contract out amnesiac shellfish poisoning sample analysis to a private laboratory. Funds are no longer required in the All Other line category for the purpose originally intended because the department has determined that the cost of these two items will decrease reliance on private labs for this work. The department faces new biotoxin threats due to the increasing seawater temperatures.
