Statutes

Statutes are the written laws enacted by the Legislature. They address many subjects. You can search or browse Maine's statutes online.

Contact the Law Library if you're having trouble finding a law on your topic.

Court Rules

Court rules explain in detail the procedures you must follow for your case to be considered by the Courts. Maine's court rules are available online. Contact the Law Library for resources that can help you understand them.
