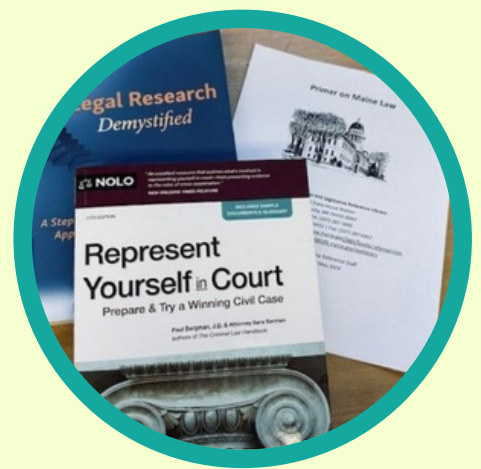


What Is Maine's Law On?
