Review of Citizen Initiative Process

The Government Oversight Committee (GOC) added a review of the Citizen Initiative Process to OPEGA's Work Plan on November 9, 2017 following consideration of a GOC member's request for a review and OPEGA's case study research on the York County Casino Referendum. The GOC directed that OPEGA submit a recommendation on project direction in January 2018.

On January 26, 2018, the GOC voted to continue with a more detailed review of the Citizen Initiative Process and approved the following scope questions:

- 1. What are the trends in activity and characteristics for people's veto and direct initiative efforts over time?
- 2. What has been the geographic distribution for signatures collected on people's vetoes and direct initiatives that qualified for the ballot?
- 3. To what extent have direct initiatives that qualified for the ballot in the last twenty years dealt with matters that had previously been before the Legislature?
- 4. What opportunities exist to improve the efficiency, effectiveness and economical use of resources in the people's veto and direct initiative processes?
- 5. What opportunities exist to improve transparency and accountability in people's veto and direct initiative efforts?

OPEGA expects to complete this review in the third quarter of 2018.
