

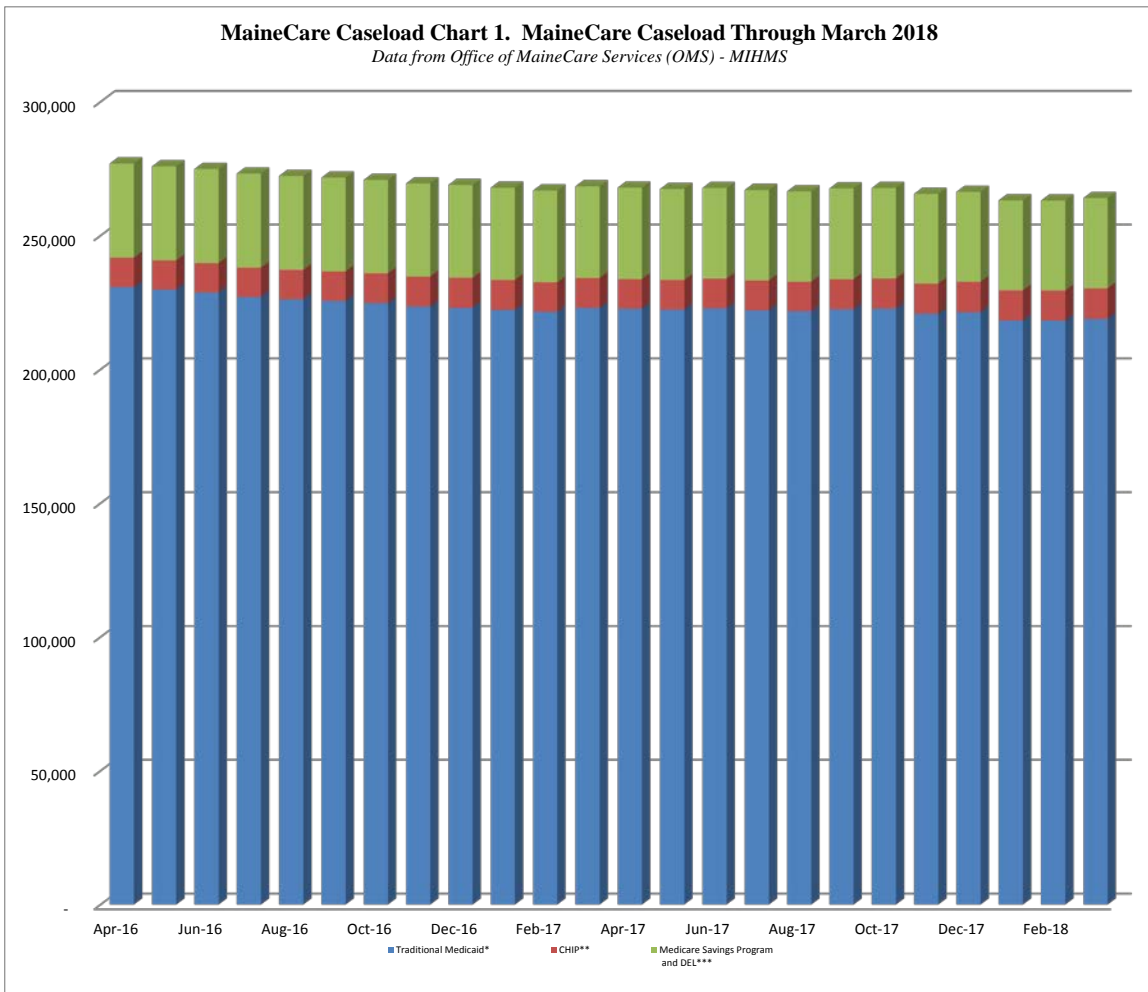
# OFPR Caseload Review through 3rd Quarter SFY 2018

## MaineCare Caseload

MaineCare caseload data for FY 2018 released by the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of MaineCare Services (OMS) show aggregate MaineCare caseload continuing to decrease, with a slight increase in the most recent month. MaineCare caseload decreased by 2,683 persons (1.00%) over the last 12 months, or just under 225 persons per month.

The only significant increase over the last 12 months is in the Family Planning category (see Table 3 below). PL 2015 c.356 [An Act To Strengthen the Economic Stability of Qualified Maine Citizens by Expanding Coverage of Reproductive Health Care and Family Services] increased the federal poverty level (FPL) for family planning only services through MaineCare to 209%. The individuals entering MaineCare due to the increased FPL are in this new caseload category.

MaineCare Caseload Chart 1 shows OMS caseload data over time, while MaineCare Caseload Table 1 shows the caseload summary over that period. MaineCare Caseload Chart 2 shows OMS caseload data by membership group over the last 6 months, while MaineCare Caseload Table 2 shows the caseload detail with membership categories, membership groups and age categories over the last 6 months.

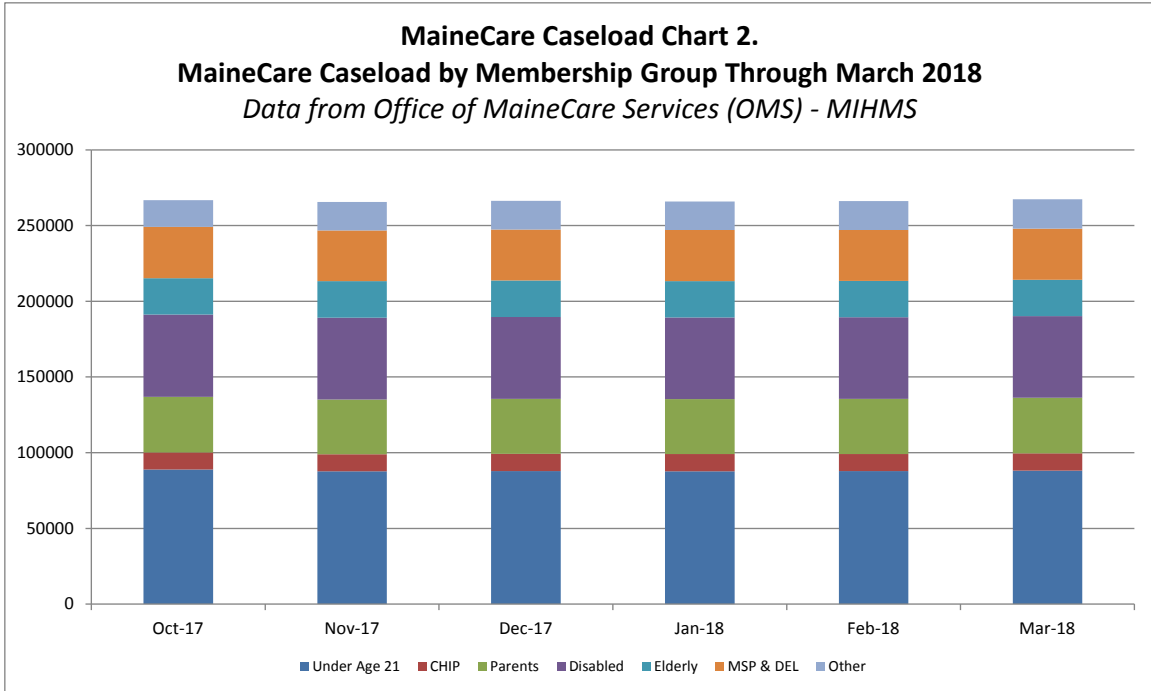
