**Medical Use Marijuana Fund**

The baseline budget for the Medical Use Marijuana Fund can be found on page A-3 of the budget document. This program administers the Medical Use of Marijuana Program. The program was transferred to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services in 2019 as part of Public Law 2017, chapter 409 - An Act To Implement a Regulatory Structure for Adult Use Marijuana.
