PL 1993, c. 707 Pt. FF-1 repealed the language establishing salary range 9 for the Assistant Secretary of the Senate and the Assistant Clerk of the House from 3 MRSA §162-A. The range was subsequently increased from 9 to 11 as a result of the 1993 NCSL Study and from 11 to 12 as a result of the 1999 NCSL Study. In 2000 range 13 was authorized for the Assistant Secretary of the Senate and the Assistant Clerk of the House. The range has remained the same for these positions since that time.

PL 1993, c. 6 amended 3 MRSA §162-A to allow prior service in the Offices of the Secretary of the Senate or Clerk of the House to be taken into consideration in assigning individuals to steps within the statutory ranges.

Longevity steps available based on years of service.

Step 9 - 10 years of service (Range 13 - \$119,018 & Range 14 - \$130,894)

Additional longevity steps authorized effective 10/1/17:

Step 10 - 12 years of service (Range 13 - \$123,802 & Range 14 - \$136,136)

Step 11 - 14 years of service (Range 13 - \$128,773 & Range 14 - \$141,606)

Step 12 - 16 years of service (Range 13 - \$133,931 & Range 14 - \$147,285)
