The federal government acquired 150 million BinaxNOW rapid COVID-19 tests. Maine is receiving 400,000 of them through the end of the year. These rapid tests will allow symptomatic individuals and/or close contacts of COVID-19 positive individuals to determine whether they have COVID-19 in a fast and secure way. Public Law 2019, Chapter 618, An Act To Address Funding Needs Related to COVID-19, authorized the use of up to \$11,000,000 from the Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital to address funding needs related to the novel coronavirus, known as COVID-19.
