Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment to fund the newly received Families First Coronavirus Response Act grant. Funding is needed for supplemental foods, health care referrals, nutrition education for low-income pregnant, breastfeeding, and non-breastfeeding postpartum women, and for infants and children up to age five who are found to be at nutritional risk. This grant will also pay administrative costs.

Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funding for increased State funded Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program benefits issued from April 2020 to December 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic to assist eligible Maine citizens with meeting their basic needs. Costs incurred by the Department of Health and Human Services are for emergency supplements to eligible citizens based on a public health emergency declaration by the Secretary of Health and Human Services under section 319 of the Public Health Service Act when a state has also issued an emergency or disaster declaration. These funds are provided through the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act.

Statement of Fact

The University of Maine System has incurred substantial unbudgeted costs related to COVID-19. This financial order will cover costs related to COVID-19 testing of students and employees and testing the wastewater on campuses to monitor public health conditions; personal protective equipment including but not limited to masks, face shields, hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes purchased for each campus; and quarantining students including delivered food services (meals, snacks, groceries, and other items required in the rooms to refrigerate or heat food) and isolation rooms in hotels and residence halls (including but not limited to cleaning, laundry, disposable sheets and sanitization supplies).
