Statement of Fact

This financial order provides partial funding for one limited-period Public Service Manager III position and one limited-period Public Service Coordinator II position established and the remainder of funding provided for in separate financial orders in fiscal year 2020-21. The positions will begin on March 1, 2021 and end on February 28, 2023. The Department is creating the Office of Federal Emergency Relief Programs to provide management and direction of federal grant awards received as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Public Service Manager III position will serve as Director to oversee program staff, stakeholder relationships and program stewardship, and the Public Service Coordinator II position will serve as a subject matter expert for the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund grant (CFDA #84.425C) to ensure successful and efficient management of the award. Failure to approve this financial order will result in the inability to adequately oversee multiple federal grant awards related to COVID-19.
