656	MSP	TT	This Part directs the Department of Health and Human Services to submit a Medicaid state plan amendment to remove the income disregard and effectively reduce the income limits to the federal minimums required in the Medicare savings program. 657	DEL	UU	This part includes a liquid asset test of no more than \$50,000 per person or \$75,000 per couple in eligibility determinations for the Low Cost Drugs for the Elderly and Disabled program. This is the same asset test used for the Medicare Savings Program (MSP).		IN 12-1

659	DHHS Mgmt	WW	This Part allows remaining balances at the end of each fiscal year in the Consumer Directed Services program and the Bridging Rental Assistance Program General Fund accounts in the Department of Health and Human Services to be carried forward for use by the program in the next fiscal year. 661	Public Assistance	YY	This Part authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services to transfer funds appropriated for state supplemental income for blind, disabled and elderly people authorized under sections 3271 and 3274 by financial order to the Department of Health and Human Services Department-wide account. It repeals the provision that requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide a food supplement program for non-citizens who would be eligible for federal SNAP benefits but for their status as aliens under the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996.  2. It repeals the provision that requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide supplemental security income for non-citizens who would be eligible for federal Supplemental Security Income but for their status as aliens under the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996.  3. It repeals the provision that requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide financial assistance to individuals who would be eligible for Temporary Assistance to Needy Families but their status as aliens under the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996. It authorizes the transfer by financial order of available Personal Services balances in the Disproportionate Share - Dorothea Dix Psychiatric Center program, the Disproportionate Share - Riverview Psychiatric Center program and the Riverview Psychiatric Center program in order to provide funds for an electronic medical records system.
