That the State Controller increase allotment in account 013-10A-0143-19, CARES Federal Project Grants - COVID19, by \$14,148,644 in the All Other line category for the purpose of providing funding to address COVID-19 related health disparities among high risk and underserved populations; and,

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022," for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funding to address health disparities among populations that are considered high-risk and underserved, including racial and ethnic minority populations and rural communities in Maine. Examples of populations considered to be high risk are women, LGBTQ+ individuals, and people with disabilities. Funding will be used to expand existing and/or develop new mitigation and prevention resources, infrastructure support and services to reduce and prevent COVID-19 among these high-risk populations. Improved data collection and reporting methods will be implemented and will focus resources to prevent illness and death in populations that are experiencing a disproportionate burden of the COVID-19 infection, severe illness, and death. Funding is provided by the COVID-19 Health Disparities grant authorized by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations (CRRSA) Act.

That the State Controller transfer \$1,431,746 from the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant, to the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health, to fund mental health crisis support services; and,
Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller decrease allotment in the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant, and increase allotment in the All Other line category in account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health, by \$1,431,746; and,
Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022," for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order will provide allotment to fund mental health crisis support services for children and their families when children are experiencing a behavioral health crisis. These services will reduce the number of hours spent in hospital emergency departments and will allow children to remain safely at home with their family. This is an effort to strengthen existing crisis services for children and their families to national best practice standards, by offering clinical support and crisis de-escalation in the family home for up to six weeks. Supplemental funding is provided by the Community Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG) program through the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplement Appropriations Act (CRRSAA). This is a grant award that is shared between the Office of Behavioral Health and the Office of Child and Family Services. The full grant award was allotted in error by Financial Order CV0285 F2 to account 015-10A-Z198-93, CARES Community Mental Health Services Block Grant. A portion of this grant should have been allotted to account 015-10A-Z206-93, CARES Community Mental Health.
