Statement of Fact

The Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention (Maine CDC) received a two-year Public Health Crisis Response grant (CFDA #93.354) through the American Rescue Plan Act in July 2021. This grant requires that at least 25% of the award support school-based health programs, including nurses or other personnel. The telehealth school nursing model was chosen to expand the reach of school nursing services due to the shortage of school nurses nationwide. The Maine Department of Education (DOE) will administer the telehealth portion of the grant with management and oversight by the Maine CDC. Funds will be used to contract with a telehealth services provider. DOE will provide outreach to eligible Maine schools, coordinate and monitor services and collect service data to ensure compliance with the terms of the grant award.

Statement of Fact

This financial order provides funding for an increase in services needed by homeless youth with Serious Emotional Disturbance (SED) due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Grant funds will be used to purchase safety supplies, antigen tests, and will also be used for a contracted position to develop a program that will coordinate services for children. The program will provide complete and complex services to youth in need, referred to as High Fidelity Wraparound Services. These services include counseling, case management, service coordination, crisis care and family support. This contracted position will build a sustainable High Fidelity Wraparound service model, create a Request for Proposal, initiate a contract that will be responsible for working with the Office of Child and Family Services and Federal Technical Assistance providers to create the foundation of Wraparound Maine for Medicaid-eligible youth. Funding is provided by the Block Grant for Community Mental Health Services authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act.


