Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment for Maine Emergency Management Agency to continue the Public Assistance Program for COVID-19. This is the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and State of Maine Agreement for the COVID-19 major disaster designated as FEMA-4522DR-ME, under the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, PL 93-288 (1974). The disaster funding continues to provide 100% federal reimbursement of eligible expenses associated with this disaster. In addition, FEMA is providing reimbursement for vaccination and testing clinics that meet the federal requirements. Funding is provided by the Department of Homeland Security.

Statement of Fact

This financial order provides allotment for supplemental funding received to prevent and mitigate the effects of domestic violence and sexual assault. Multiple services related to family violence, that may be pandemic related, include COVID-19 testing and vaccines, education and outreach, transportation, childcare, housing of domestic violence survivors, and crisis and support services for sexual assault survivors. Funding is provided by the Family Violence Prevention and Services/Domestic Violence Shelter and Support Services grant (FVPSA-DV) and the Family Violence Prevention and Services/Sexual Assault/Rape Crisis Services and Supports grant (FVPSA-SA) through the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.
