**Statement of Fact**

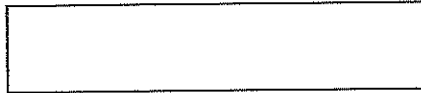

The General and Highway funds being transferred from All Other are no longer needed for the purpose for which they were intended, as remaining resources will meet existing operational needs.
