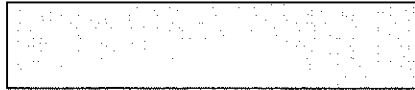

that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2023", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order will allot a portion of the estimated unencumbered balance forward so that the Board of Licensure in Medicine can purchase a microfilm scanner. All applications for licensure are archived on microfilm and any applications prior to 2016 are not available in an electronic format. This scanner will allow quicker access to archived records and will enhance the Board's ability to verify information from applicants prior to 2016. Failure to allot these funds will result in the agency not able to verify archived information in a more timely manner.

ORDERED,

That the State Controller increase allotment in account 014-65A-0184-03, PUC Reimbursement Fund by \$306,000 in the All Other line category for the purpose of allotting a portion of the anticipated unencumbered balance forward for contractual services for public education and outreach; and,

Be it further ordered,
that the State Controller authorize the expenditure in accordance with the attached "Revision of the Work Program for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2023", for which this shall be our sufficient warrant.

Statement of Fact

This financial order allots a portion of the anticipated balance forward to cover the cost of multimedia services to enhance marketing, communications and public relations and education efforts. The Commission's core function is to ensure that Maine citizens have access to safe and reliable utility services at rates that are just and reasonable for customers and public utilities. To help educate the public, funds will be used for: a safety campaign for the Dig Safe Program, social media graphic design for general education and outreach, a market survey, and a public-education campaign to inform electric utility customers about options for choosing electricity supply and how to avoid predatory marketing.

Failure to approve this financial order will have a detrimental impact on the program resulting in the inability of the Commission to effectively educate the public, thus potentially causing adverse consequences in terms of cost, safety, and reliability for Maine consumers.
