This grant requires that at least 25% of the award support <u>school-based health</u> programs including nurses or other personnel. The Maine CDC has approved additional projects to utilize the remaining funds including continuing an ongoing contract for 4 School Nurse Regional Liaisons, provide scholarships and create a cohort for nurses to help prepare them for taking the National Certification exam and to contract with an evaluator to provide a state assessment of the implementation of the current school health services. The intention was to encumber contracts for the additional projects in fiscal year 2021-2022, but the contracts were not ready for encumbrance until fiscal year 2022-2023 and there currently is not enough allotment to cover these encumbrances. This financial order increases the allotment so these contracts can be encumbered.
