**Statement of Fact**

This financial order allots available resources in the Risk Management Claims account. Funding is required for the probability of increased claims. Increased property losses and higher construction costs have repair rates rising significantly. Risk Management is experiencing more property losses, many due to aging assets, and the cost of construction has increased repair rates upwards of 30%. Additionally, the impact of COVID-19, cyber-attacks and catastrophes have created globally volatile insurance markets with premiums increasing at historically high rates. Failure to allot these funds can result in the agency's inability to pay settlement claims quickly or meet costs of premiums.

**Statement of Fact**

This financial order transfers All Other to Personal Services to establish one limited-period Marine Resource Scientist I position and 3 limited-period Marine Resource Specialist II positions. The Marine Resource Scientist I position will coordinate seasonal trawl surveys within and around the Gulf of Maine Floating Offshore Wind Research Array to evaluate impacts of wind energy areas on marine resources. The Marine Resource Specialist II positions will assist scientists in planning, coordinating and conducting research projects in the offshore research array. These projects will help with answering questions about the impact of Maine's offshore wind area on marine resources. The positions will start on September 26, 2022 and end on September 25, 2024. Funds are no longer required in All Other for the purpose for which they were originally intended because the anticipated expense is Personal Services in nature.

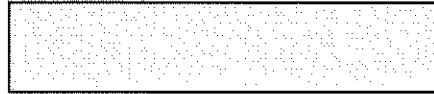
